Introduction

Welcome to the regular spring PhD Scientific Days 2016 Conference, which provides an opportunity for PhD students from each of the seven Doctoral Schools of Semmelweis University to network and present their latest research and clinical findings during the 8 oral and 4 poster sessions. This year we have guest students from the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Tirgu Mures, Romania. The location of this spring conference used to be at Semmelweis University but this year due to infrastructural developments we enjoy the hospitality of one of our partner institutions, Institute of Experimental Medicine of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.

The primary objective of the conference is that PhD students and candidates should present and discuss their doctoral research in a professional environment. It is expected that participants will benefit from questions and intellectual advice related to their presentations and they will widen and strengthen professional relationships. From the fall semester 2016 the PhD curricula will change significantly due to a new two staged 4- year- program. Perhaps the major change will be the interim qualification exam. The regular spring PhD Scientific Days in the previous system had a similar but informal role to monitor the professional development of the PhD students. Best students from the 8 oral and 4 poster sessions will be selected by a jury and will be awarded a travel fellowship for a conference of choice.

In the frame of the program of the PhD Scientific Days 2016 Conference, professors Éva Szökő and László Kopper, holders of ?Excellent PhD Supervisor Award?, and guest speakers, Beáta Sperlágh and Gábor Kovács have been invited to present their rich and divers research achievements. The event is open to graduate and postgaduate students, peers, junior and senior faculty members from Semmelweis University and from other universities.
